DEAR PARISHIONERS

Thanks to all those who volunteered and helped celebrate our 86th annual Garden Party. I appreciate the sacrifice and the extra effort to work around our construction project. After 85 years the show just had to go on. Thanks for the work and for the show!

Our construction project will be going through some changes in the next week or so. The main thing we will notice is the new parking lots. As they are completed and put into use, the construction fences will be moved onto the existing parking lot where we will be building the new addition to the school. During the remainder of construction, the only entrances to the main parking lot will be on the Walnut street side. The Glenwood entrance will not be open until construction is complete next spring. The parking lot at Walnut and Laurel will have an entrance on Walnut and from the alley off of Laurel.

There will be no parking available behind the chapel. We will not have lights on the main parking lot until the construction is completed next spring. Those who go to the chapel for adoration will probably find that parking is the easiest and most secure along Laurel in front of the church. We are not able to get disability spaces marked in front of the Church along Laurel. However, for Sunday Masses, please be considerate of those with disabilities and leave the spots in front of the church for them. There will be spaces marked in the Laurel parking lot. By this fall there should be a new sidewalk from the sidewalk in front of the church along Laurel to the ramp by the front door to make entrance for those with disabilities easier.

This week we are offering Vacation Bible School. This is another way to continue to help our children learn and grow in faith even in the summer months. Many of you have already been involved with this wonderful apostolate for our children. Thank you for your support. Please keep the children and the volunteers in your prayers this week.
