GROUND RULES

Classes meet from 6:30pm to 7:45pm on Wednesday evenings in Blessed Sacrament School. Please have the children in the school **no earlier than 6:20pm**; supervision becomes a problem if they are in the building much earlier.

Please enter and leave by the **west door** on Laurel Street, the other doors will be locked.

Children in **grades one, two, and three must be picked up from their classrooms** by adults. By dismissal time it is dark and thus dangerous to have children outside alone. Please advise us if there is any custody issue of which we should be aware regarding who picks up your children.

If a child is not going to be in class on a particular evening, please tell the office (not just the teacher) beforehand if it is a planned absence. To inform us of an absence either call the school office **after** 6:00pm on Wednesdays or call Deacon Dave Erdman and **leave a message** any time. Do not call the school during the day. If your child is absent from class and we have not been notified we are obliged to call you.

Feel free to call Deacon Dave Erdman or your child's teacher at any time with comments, questions, suggestions, etc. We are here to assist you in your role as primary religious educator of your children. Advise us on how we can best do this. We do have a precious few hours with them each year, and we would like this time to affirm what you are doing at home.

The faculty will keep you in their prayers all year; please ask the Holy Spirit to guide us in the way to bring these children closer to God.
