

# Permission Slip for Personal Safety Training

Each year the diocese asks each parish to provide a personal safety training session for all of its students. This training covers issues regarding stranger safety, protecting yourself against sexual abuse and information regarding peer pressure. Each class is shown an age-appropriate video and then has a teacher led discussion on the material that was presented. This year's session will take place in the fall. Reminders will be sent home in the weeks prior to the event. The video titles for each class in previous years are as follows:

- 1<sup>st</sup> Grade: What Tadoo
- 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> Grades: What Tadoo with Secrets
- 4<sup>th</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup> Grades: When Should You Tell
- 6<sup>th</sup> and 7<sup>th</sup> Grades: How not to be a Victim
- 8<sup>th</sup> Grade: No Excuses, Sexual Harassment
